- <sup>1</sup> ACCT 2103 may be taken as a substitute for ACCT 2101 & 2102. Credit will not be given for both ACCT 2101 and /or ACCT 2102 & ACCT 2103. Students taking ACCT 2103 must take an additional 3 credit elective (see Note 6) to substitute for ACCT 2101/2102.
- <sup>2</sup> Choose from History (HIST), English (ENGL 2XXX) except ENGL 2045 and 2070, or Communications (CMCN) except CMCN 1170, 1270, and 2145.
- <sup>3</sup> Choose from Anthropology (ANTH), Criminal Justice (CJUS), Economics (ECON), Geography (GEOG), Political Science (POLI), Psychology (PSYC), or Sociology (SOCI).
- <sup>4</sup> Choose from General Business (GBUS) 1060, 2075, 2080 or Computers (MCIS) 1010, 1030.
- <sup>5</sup> Choose from Biology (BIOL), Chemistry (CHEM), Environmental Science (ENSC), Geology (GEOL), Physical Science (PHSC), or Physics (PHYS). Students planning to transfer to a 4-year institution are encouraged to complete two courses in the same science discipline.
- <sup>6</sup> Choose from Business (GBUS 1060, GBUS 2010, GBUS 2020, GBUS 2030, GBUS 2060, GBUS 2065, GBUS 2075, GBUS 2080) or Computers (MCIS 1010, MCIS1030), Humanities (note 2), Social/Behavioral Sciences (note 3), Natural/Physical Sciences (note 5), Math (MATH) course at a higher level than MATH 1105, Fine Arts (ARTS), Theater (THEA), Music (MUSC), French (FREN), Spanish (SPAN), Speech (SPCH) or First-Year Seminar (SFSE). Electives should be selected with the assistance of an advisor.
