

The LPN to RN transition track is designed for currently employed licensed practical nurses (LPN) to complete accelerated academic coursework in preparation for the NCLEX-RN, the national registered nursing (RN) licensure exam. The track includes three semesters of coursework combined with credit for prior learning. Applicants should have three years of experience as an LPN.

⁴ It is highly recommended that students complete BIOL 2100 before applying to the LPN to RN –Transition track.

⁵ Students will receive credit for prior learning for NURS 1100 and NURS 2100 upon completion of NURS 1000 and NURS 1200 with a grade of “C” or better.
