Scheduling Tips

- Many classes can be taken in **any semester**. This sheet contains a suggested sequence only.
 - Completing English and math early during your college career is helpful. They're often prerequisites for more advanced classes.
 - **Note: Remedial classes** (ENGL 0083, ENGL 0093, MATH 0083, and MATH 0093) do not apply toward your degree plan. If you are placed in a remedial class, this class must be completed IN ADDITION to the 60 credits on your degree plan.
- For **English** classes, use your placement guide to determine where to start:
 - ENGL 0083 OR
 - ENGL 1010 and ENGL 0093 OR
 - ENGL 1010
- For **math** classes, use your placement guide to determine where to start:
 - MATH 0083 OR
 - MATH 1105 AND MATH 0093 OR
 - MATH 1105
- Review your **Business degree plan** for graduation requirements, including minimum grades and course exceptions. Not all courses are applicable to your degree plan.
