

## DEGREE NOTES

A Certificate of General Studies is awarded upon the completion of ENGL IOIO, ENGL IO20, MATH 1105 or MATH 2020, two (2) Elective Courses, and one course in each of the following categories: Fine Arts, Humanities, Social/Behavioral Science, Natural/Physical Science, and General Education Elective.

Transfer information: 2+2 Articulation Agreements. SLCC offers a limited number of 2+2 programs in general studies transfer tracks. $2+2$ programs are designed for SLCC graduates who intend to transfer to specific 4 -year institutions. Students complete the requirements for their SLCC general studies degree by taking courses that will apply to their future major at a specific 4 -year institution. ## Scheduling Tips

Many classes can be taken in any semester. This sheet contains a suggested sequence only.

- Completing English and math early during your college career is helpful. They're often prerequisites for more advanced classes.
- Note: Remedial classes (ENGL 0083, ENGL 0093, MATH 0083, and MATH 0093) do not apply toward your degree plan. If you are placed in a remedial class, this class must be completed IN ADDITION to the 60 credits on your degree plan.

For English classes, use your placement guide to determine where to start:

- ENGL 0083 OR
- ENGL 1010 and ENGL 0093 OR
- ENGL IOIO

For math classes, use your placement guide to determine where to start:

- MATH 0083 OR
- MATH II 05 AND MATH 0093 OR
- MATH II05 OR
- MATH 2020
